## 2008 USJN EVENT/GAME RULES

**PLAYING RULES:** All games are played using National Federation rules, and the following additions:

- 1 + 1 on the 10th foul of the half − 2 shot foul after 14<sup>th</sup> foul.
- 10 second in backcourt
- Play the release of the ball on Free Throws
- 6 Fouls per player

TIMEOUTS: 2 full, 2 - 30 second TO per game

**TIME:** Games will be played with two 16 minute halves stopping clock on all whistles, 4 minute halftime.

**OVERTIME:** 3 minutes and one additional Full Timeout; 2OT = Sudden Death (except playoffs – In playoffs 2OT = 2min with one additional Full Timeout and 3OT till end = 1min with no more additional Timeouts).

**PRE-GAME WARM-UP TIME:** As much time as available before the scheduled start time. **3 minutes if the game is starting after the scheduled start time**. If this is a Division I recruiting period event ALL games may NOT begin early.

FORFEIT RULE: 15 Minute forfeit time.

\*\*\*USJN site director has right to override forfeit rules due to extraordinary circumstances\*\*\*

**ROSTER:** 15 players max, three coaches per team PER New NCAA Rules – All SIDELINE COACHES <u>MUST PRESENT THEIR NCAA APPROVAL NUMBER</u> TO RECEIVE A BRACELET TO WEAR AT ALL TIMES

**FORMAT:** See tournament format as each USJN event is different. First tie breaker (2 way tie) goes head to head. Second tie breaker (3 way tie) goes + / - point differential. Most you can receive is + / - 20 pts. There may be 'Wildcard' Entries to tournament play based on number of teams involved in the event. If Wildcard spot tie = coin toss

\*\*\*Coaches are responsible to confirm win/loss records which will be posted at the main site. Please note coaches are responsible to find out when all playoff games are scheduled and played. A team representative must contact the site director to verify playoff status. USJN does not notify teams of playoff status.\*\*\*

\*\*Teams are responsible for 'warm up' & game ball \*\*

\*\*There is no designated 'home team' as some teams only have one set of uniforms so please bring both sets to all games\*\*

COACHES MUST CHECK FINAL SCORE ON SCORE SHEET, INITIAL THE CORRECT FINAL SCORE FOR THEIR TEAM, & VOTE FOR POOL ALL-STARS
